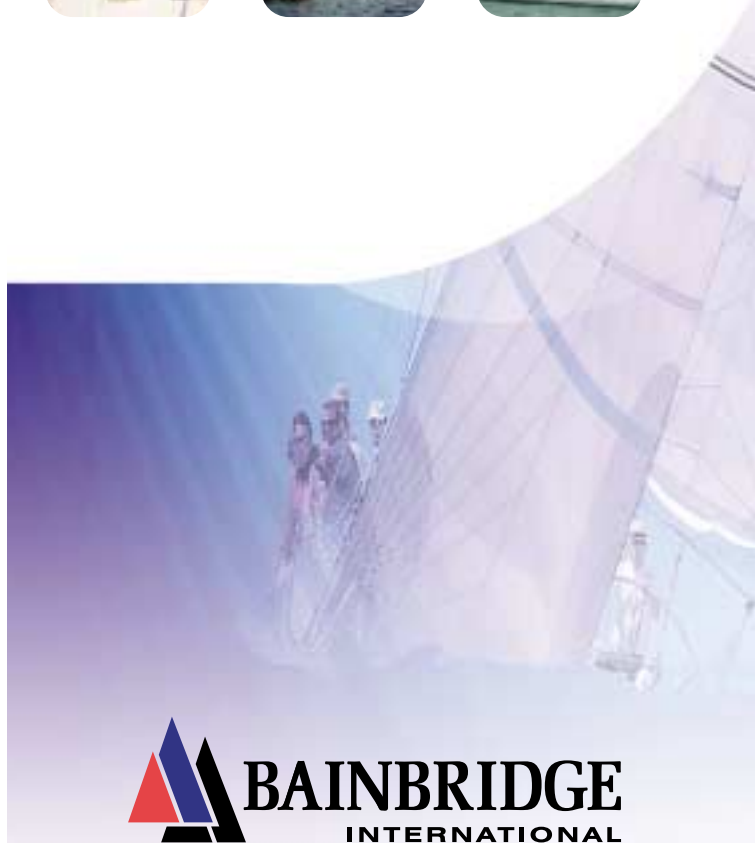

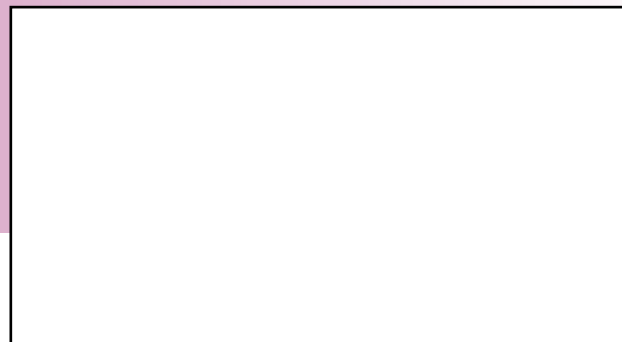

- Clean regularly to prevent dirt becoming embedded in the fabric.
- Loose dirt can be simply brushed off.
- For more intensive cleaning hose down the cover and clean with warm natural soap solution. Rinse thoroughly.
- Covers should be clean and dry before winter storage.

- *Do not use detergents or chlorine solutions as these can damage the water repellent coatings.*
- *Do not iron, tumble dry or subject fabric to extreme heat.*

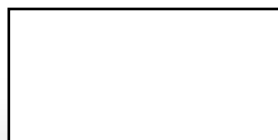

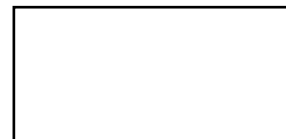
